

I.C.E In Case of Emergency

On your phone, load the following contact: I C E

This means: In Case of Emergency

The telephone number you enter for your **ICE** contact will be that of the person you wish the Emergency Services (i.e. Ambulance) should contact if you are incapacitated (unconscious).

This can be your **husband**, **wife**, **child** or **parents**.

Example Contact: ICE - Father or ICE - Hubby

Why is this Important?

This is very important, not only to notify your family members of your where-abouts (i.e. which hospital the ambulance took you to), but also to find out if you have any allergies, what medication you take, etc. All of which is necessary for your treatment.

It is also important so your personal effects can be collected, and not get lost.

ICE your phone now!

Emergency personnel are trained to look for this number on your mobile phone.
